

The Lunch Money Jingle Price List

Give each student the “Lunch Money Jingle” counting chart. Be sure each student has coins at his/her desk. Students should manipulate their coins as you instruct everyone to “show me what 35 cents looks like.” Once they have placed their coins in the first column, ask if they can show you a different way. If there is still another way to show you the coin amount, invite them to place the denominations in the 3rd column.
